



Step 1

Unlock your iPhone.

Step 2

Open the *Health* application that comes pre-loaded onto your iPhone. The application's icon is a solid white square with a small pink heart in the corner.





Step 3


Once the application is open, there will be four options at the bottom of the screen. You will select the icon in the bottom right-hand corner titled *Medical ID*.






Once you have selected *Medical ID*, simply click on *Create Medical ID* near the center of the screen.





Step 5

Fill in your personal health information starting with your date of birth. In *Medical Notes*, you can add the Baylor St. Luke's Emergency Center nearest to you.
